

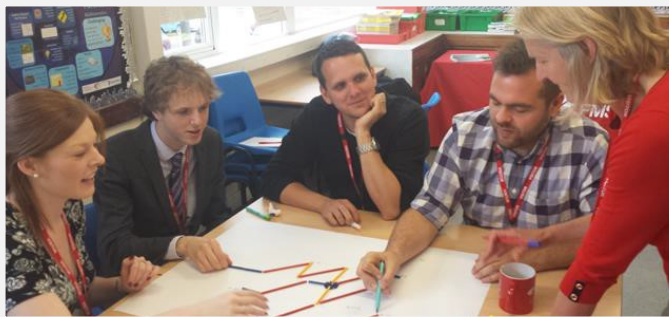
The Further Mathematics Support Programme

A one-day conference for sixth form students and their teachers developing deeper mathematical problem solving skills.

Aimed at ALL Y12 and Y13 students who are likely to study Mathematics or related subjects at University, this day will be of particular interest to those who:



- have been (or are likely to be) invited to a selection interview at University
- will be taking STEP or AEA examinations in 2017 or 2018
- will be taking the MAT or similar examinations in 2017

... and at teachers who are supporting such students.

This event is **FREE** for students and accompanying teachers from state funded schools. The workshop sessions will focus on different ways of looking at example problems and how to approach writing solutions. Accompanying teachers will have the opportunity to work on problems with their students.
