Preparing for the New Mathematics A Levels – Selecting the ‘correct’ Specification

At this meeting:

The content for A level Mathematics is 100% specified by the DfE. How, then, do you decide which specification will be the most appropriate for your students?

To help you to make an informed decision, we will be comparing available specifications to identify the different approaches that exam boards have taken in the structure of their assessments, the style of questioning that they have used and their approaches to assessing the overarching themes of reasoning and proof, problem solving and modelling, and work with large data sets.

This will be a ‘hands on’ session and is recommended to all teachers of A level Mathematics.
