

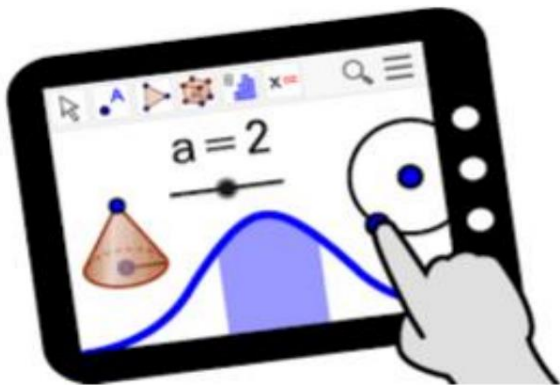

We aim to provide the opportunity to explore and build confidence in the use of some of the resources that are easy to implement in the classroom and give students a rich and rewarding learning experience in their exploration of mathematical concepts.

Suitable for teachers of AS and A level Mathematics

Focus for the day

An opportunity to reflect of the implications surrounding the requirement for the use of technology to permeate maths teaching, explore the use of free graphics applications, spreadsheets and the latest calculators.

Course aims:

- To provide teachers with an overview of these accessible technologies
- To give teachers time to explore and gain familiarity with GeoGebra and/or Desmos and what they can do
- To give information about calculator options that satisfy the new requirements
- To help teachers to build their own expertise in the use of free apps and new calculators
- To look at how these technologies can enhance the learning experience

Notes: If possible you should bring your own lap top or tablet, although computers will be available at the venue for your use. GeoGebra and Desmos are freely available online and previous experience is not necessary.
