Functions and Graphs in the New GCSE

A one-day course focusing on teaching functions and graphs for the new Higher Tier GCSE, enabling mathematics teachers both to challenge KS4 students and to develop student understanding.

- Consider ways of developing a deep understanding of functions and graphs in the new Higher Tier GCSE
- Become familiar with a range of free resources and develop strategies to teach this content.
- Consider how best to prepare pupils for the new Higher Tier GCSE questions related to functions and graphs.
- A brief look at how these topics develop at A level

Developing Reasoning and Proof at GCSE

A one-day course focusing on teaching proof for the new Higher Tier GCSE, enabling mathematics teachers both to challenge KS4 students and to develop student understanding.

Course aims:

- Consider the development of reasoning, justification and proof, focusing on Higher Tier GCSE content, but also looking at the wider locus of development.
- Familiarise teachers with a range of free resources and develop strategies to teach this content.
- Consider how best to prepare pupils for the new Higher Tier GCSE questions related to reasoning, justification and proof.
- A brief look at how these topics develop at A level.
