- The conference is aimed at Y10 students, and will extend students' experiences beyond GCSE Mathematics.
- We aim to inspire students to continue to study Mathematics at a higher level.
- There will be no charge for state funded schools.

All students will be able to attend 3 out of a possible 5 sessions (the students will be allocated to these sessions). The five sessions will be a mixture of topics but these could include Maths of the Rubik's Cube, Exploring Different Geometries, Mobius Strips, and Fractals. All students will be included in the final session, 'The Hidden Maths of Technology' by Zoe Griffiths.

We will require a member of staff from each school to help with supervision of students. Each school will be responsible for transport arrangements for their students. Students and staff will be expected to bring a packed lunch with them. In the first instance schools are limited to a maximum of 10 students but please make it clear if you would like to bring more students if bookings allow this.
