

# MAT and STEP course for high-achieving Year 12 and 13 students

The very successful MAT and STEP course which the SE London Maths Hub and the FMSP ran last year at Greenwich University's Maths Department will run again in 2017-8.

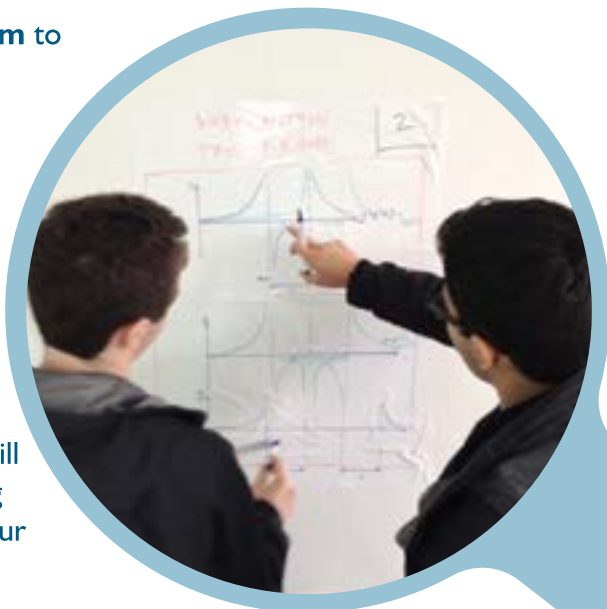
There are two strands to this course: one aimed at Year 12 students (MAT/STEP 1), and one for Year 13 students (mainly looking at STEP 2 and 3).

The course will run over 11 sessions (14 sessions for Y13/STEP 2 and 3 students), starting on **Saturday 25<sup>th</sup> November**.

Each session runs from **9.30am to 1pm**.

Each of the course's strands will be led by two highly experienced Sixth Form Maths teachers.

Students must be registered by a teacher and the sessions are free. High demand means that non-attendance will lead to a student's place being given to another student on our waiting list.
