- You are currently studying A-level Mathematics and you enjoy solving challenging problems.

The sessions offer students the opportunity to develop their problem-solving skills by trying out challenging problems that require deep mathematical thinking, and so help them achieve the grades they need to get into the university or a career of their choice.

The problems students will tackle are fun and rewarding. Attending the sessions will enrich students' mathematical experience. Students will look at problems from a range of sources including Sixth Term Examination Papers, Advanced Extension Award and Oxford Entrance Papers.
