STEP 2 and 3 Preparation Course 2018

These classes are intended for Year 13 mathematics students who are required to sit STEP 2 and/or STEP 3 papers for university entrance. They will cover the Pure Mathematics syllabus only and will concentrate on the techniques which are beyond the A-level specification. They will be invaluable for examination preparation and will help students bridge the gap between school and university mathematics. The classes will be taken by Dr. Luciano Rila who is very experienced in STEP preparation.
