We invite applications for a full time Teaching Fellow in Mathematics. As a Teaching Fellow you will contribute to teaching and assessment activities across the Mathematics undergraduate curriculum, including lectures, tutorials and examples classes. You will also act as Area Co-ordinator for the Further Mathematics Support Programme (FMSP), which will include the management of support for local schools and colleges in the teaching and learning of Mathematics (to include Further Mathematics). This will involve working closely with another recently appointed Area Co-ordinator.

You will have a minimum 2:2 (or equivalent) undergraduate qualification, or higher degree, in Mathematics. You will have extensive experience of teaching Mathematics at an appropriate level, and the ideal candidate will also have experience of teaching and assessment in undergraduate Mathematics and/or A level Mathematics. The post requires strong organisational skills, excellent team working and communication skills. You should also demonstrate strong IT skills and be familiar with teaching and assessment in a computerised environment.

This post is funded for up to 1FTE, however the contracted hours/ weeks of work are negotiable from a minimum of 0.5 FTE and will be agreed with the successful candidate.
